
In 2019, NH LAKES launched the LakeSmart Lake-Friendly Living Program.






Lakes, like people, age over time.

They fill in with decayed plants, algae, and sediment.




















Changing land use, changing weather patterns...








Number of Self-Assessments, 2019-2022






LakeSmart rolls out slowly, one person at a time!

Treatments for mosquitos, ticks, etc. are toxic to aquatic organisms and travel into our lake through wind and rain.










Allow a sandy beach to rewild.



Embrace a natural lawn.


















Stabilize dripline areas.







Remember, your neighbors truly care about the lake and want to do their part to keep it clean and healthy.








